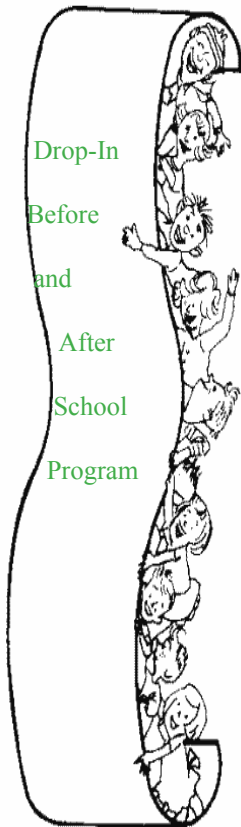

I also fully realize that I must provide proper medical and hospital coverage. The Town of Hamlin does not provide accident insurance coverage. I understand that I must come into the program location to drop off and pick up my child. Refunds will be given to anyone canceling from an activity at least one week (5 working days) prior to the start of the program. There is no refund for any program once it has begun unless it is cancelled by the Recreation Department or in the event of illness or injury and a doctor's note is provided. Refunds may be pro-rated minus the cost of uniforms and supplies.
