COMMUNITY CENTER EXPLORATORY REPORT:

The Town Board recommended at its meeting on August 8 that the Exploratory Committee continues its effort with emphasis on recommending a site. Diane reported the SUBURBAN NEWS is interested in running an article on the results of the survey. It was discussed that this would be a good way to get the word out and to encourage people to resume/begin attending the monthly Community Center Exploratory Committee meetings.

SENIOR COORDINATOR REPORT:

Executive committee met today with 10 in attendance. 81 members attended the July meeting. Senior of the month is Janice Smith. Everyone enjoyed the July 14 trip on the Grand Lady, Buffalo. August 18 is the annual "mystery trip." Only one seat remains. 32 have signed up for the 4-day Lancaster, PA trip in September with room for more. The PA Grand Canyon trip is October 13 and there is already a waiting list. The next meeting is the annual picnic at Hamlin Beach State Park, area 4, Shelter 5. Town officials including two members of Rec. Commission (Denny and Stan) will be cooking. Grills are lit off at 10:30 a.m. and cooking begins at about 11:15 a.m.

- Working with a Dell rep for a new computer to replace the old, free one from the County. New one will be much more compatible and more efficient.
- Meeting with ADNET on August 10 for a new style for the newsletter.

- Deadline for the Community Center Exploratory input to the newsletter is August 26.
- Working on Fall program, which will be much as before. Trying to add some more adult exercise such as Step Aerobics.
- Tom Ingraham will be meeting with Greg Speers from Lions Club on status of new building in playing fields. She will advise commission of meeting date and asks that anyone who can attend.
- Pat will send commission a preliminary budget to review. Budget submission deadline is September 9.

ASSISTANT DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

- Youth Group is 220 cans (of food) short of the 1,000 needed for its "can-imal" project at the Brockport Arts Festival on Saturday, August 13. Will purchase them if necessary. All canned food items will ultimately be donated to Hamlin Lifetime Solutions.
- Sea Breeze trip with ASSETS was a great time.
- Rock Festival/Concert scheduled for September 25, 2-6 p.m., hopefully on basketball court. Chaperones needed.
- Majority of coaches reported that they liked this year's refs. No major problems reported.
