DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Patty Jo provided the commission with the updated Monthly Report as well as a copy of the letter from the Monroe County Youth Bureau regarding funding for the 2009 year. Patty Jo is looking at our programs and budget to figure out ways to make cuts should we not get the full funding. The commission gave Patty Jo the go ahead to sign the contract with Zuperbounce for the summer movie series in the park. Teen campers who return to the program will be given a discount for the following year to increase each year until they age out. It was also discussed to allow the kids who participate in the playground series to be offered the discount when they age out and move up to the teen program. The discount would be as follows age 13 full price, age 14 a 25% discount, age 15 a 50% discount and at the age of 16 if they help out just the cost of trips. The commission voted to go ahead with the discount program. Patty Jo announced that the ice rink is up and should be ready to skate on this weekend. Thank you to all who helped out with this endeavor. Patty Jo is going to look into if we can use the dug outs for a shelter. The Babe Ruth will be running this spring there are now enough kids for the team.
