

**PUBLIC HEARING HAMLIN MEADOWS SUBDIVISION  
February 9, 2009**

A Public Hearing was held in the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Rd., Hamlin, New York, order on establishment of a drainage district in the Hamlin Meadows Subdivision on the south side of Roosevelt Highway, Town of Hamlin. The meeting was called to order at 7 pm by Supervisor Roach. The location of the fire exits and defibrillator was explained for those present.

Supervisor Roach asked the Town Clerk to provide proof of publication. Supervisor Roach proceeded to explain the Conduct of Public Hearing.

The purpose of this special drainage district is to enable the Town to levy a tax on only the owner(s) of parcels within the Hamlin Meadows Subdivision to cover expenses of the Town maintaining said drainage district after it is constructed and dedicated to the Town. The Public Hearing was authorized by Town Board Resolution #84-2009 of January 14, 2009. The order of Town Board for Establishment of Drainage District reads as follows:

WHEREAS, the proposed drainage improvements are shown on plans prepared by Randall E. LaDue, P.E., on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Town of Hamlin, and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount proposed to be expended is zero because the petitioner is bearing the entire costs of construction, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Town Board of the Town of Hamlin shall meet at the Town Hall, 1658 Lake Road, Hamlin, NY on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of conducting a public hearing on the proposal to establish said drainage district with the improvements specified above, at which time and place all persons interested in the subject thereof may be heard concerning the same, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Town Clerk of the Town of Hamlin, is hereby directed to publish a copy of this order in the **Hamlin-Clarkson Herald** and post a copy of the same on the signboard of the Town of Hamlin, in the time and manner required by law.
