

**UNAPPROVED MINUTES FEBRUARY 27 2018
HAMLIN SENIORS**

President Ronn Klein called the meeting to order at 11:46 am with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and a moment of silence for both those fatally wounded and those injured in the recent Florida shootings.

The February birthdays and anniversaries were announced; 'Happy Birthday' and 'Happy Anniversary' were sung to the celebrants. Linda and Jim Ohls are new members this month.

The meeting was stopped so that members could enjoy a potluck meal. The meeting was reconvened at 12:59 and Ronn introduced Corky Dailey and Wendy Thompson, nurses from Strong West, who spoke to us about their experiences during their two-week trip with other area medical personnel to Puerto Rico as medical emissaries. Many questions were asked and answered, and Ronn thanked them for sharing their experiences with the membership.

Secretary's Report: After a period for members to read the report, Charlie Hungerford moved, Janet Haight seconded to approve this report as presented. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Karen Keck presented her report showing an opening balance of \$3,645.78, expenses of \$142.63, and income of \$118.13, with cash on hand of \$35.00, the ending balance for February is \$3,656.28.

Euchre Report: Janet Haight was top scorer with 56, followed by Gary Sweeney with 55, Jim Schiebel with 53 and new member Jim Ohls had 30 points.

Sunshine Report: Janet said she had sent Sympathy Cards to: the families of Martha Goltermann and Barbara D'Aprile, and to Michelle Bliss, Rosemary Mintz and Mary Rodas for recent losses of loved ones. She also sent a 'Thinking of You' card to Karen Keck, and a Get-Well card to Marie Knittel.

Trip Reports: Sue said there are 35 people signed up for the April 21 trip to Nazareth College for a concert, which will be followed by a meal at The Farmer's Table restaurant.
