

**HAMLIN SENIORS GENERAL MEETING MINUTES
JULY 23 2019**

President Klein called the meeting to order at 11:45 am with the Pledge of Allegiance and then asked for a moment of silence to recognize the effects of our extreme heat and humidity on seniors and others in the community.

July birthdays and anniversaries were announced and we sang to those celebrating this month. Don and Phyllis Powell were introduced as new members; Barb Siebert was chosen as Senior of the Month, and Pastor Christian Bode offered the prayer before our meal.

After the meal, President Klein reconvened the meeting at 12:42 pm.

- Sec'y Rpt:** With the correction of Nancy Larnder not being the second to a motion to adjourn, this report was approved as presented.
- Treas.Rpt:** Ralph Preston moved, Anita Kile seconded to approve this report, showing an opening balance of \$4,057.01 and a closing balance of \$5,359.79. Motion carried.
- Euchre:** Euchre winners were: Anne Elphick—53; Janet Haight—51; and Butch Kile, Barb Siebert, and Jim Schiebel tied at 49.
- Sunshine:** Janet sent a sympathy card to the family of Pat Hardenbrook and to Ken & Joyce Miller.
- Day Trips:** It was reported that there are 6 tickets left for the Red Wings game on July 27, and the bus will leave the Town Hall on that day at 5:45 pm. The Albany trip has 30 people going on August 7 and returning on the 8th, and the trip to Auburn on Monday August 19 to see South Pacific has only 1 seat still open.
- Coordinator:** Michelle noted that forms are available and must be filled out for those wishing to receive their annual flu shot at the September meeting. She also distributed an updated membership list. She reminded us that Life Solutions is in need of more food donations, and told us that on August 10 there is a memorial dedication ceremony at the Hamlin Public Library to honor her mother, Carolyn Hungerford. She noted that Anne Elphick and Peg Leverenz would be in charge of getting everyone to and from the ballgame on the 27th. She reminded members that when they attend the picnic meeting at Hamlin Beach State Park, Area 4 on August 27, everyone must stop and sign in at the gate. The guard will have a list of all those signed up and will be checking your driver's licenses against that list.
- Twn Liaison:** Dave reminded us that the Recreation Commission again has a Senior Meal Program Mondays through Thursdays at the Charlie Maier Lions Lodge, 5:30 – 7:30pm. For \$5.00, anyone over the age of 55 can get a red or white hotdog, hamburger or cheeseburger, french-fries and a beverage. This will continue until the last of the Commission's sports programs are through for the summer.
