

Roosevelt Highway Water District Informational Meeting Minutes
June 26, 2019

The Hamlin Town Board held a Public Hearing Meeting on June 26, 2019 for the creation of the Roosevelt Highway Water District in the Hamlin Town Hall located at 1658 Lake Rd., Hamlin, New York. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 by Supervisor Peters who explained the location of the fire exits and defibrillator for those present.

John Paul Schepp from MRB Group discussed the general process for creation of water districts. The process had to start over because the threshold changed. The project was revamped to be under the threshold. The project will be bonded for 30 years and divided among the residents. The boundaries will remain the same as they were before, from Sweden Walker Road to Townline Road. The Engineering plans are out for permits and approvals. The project will save money having the Clarkson Highway Department complete the project. The anticipated the project to start September.

Questions from the Public

A resident mentioned it was the same as before but now it is under the threshold.

A resident asked what do they have to do now? Monroe County Water who will take over the line will have a sign-up meeting in either Hamlin, Clarkson or both.

Are we required to disconnect from our well? You can keep your well however there will be a fee for that and there are regulations on required inspections and things.

Does the well have to be capped or filled in? Monroe County Health has evolved its regulation.
